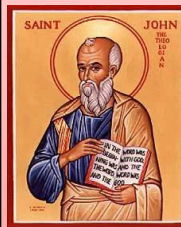
STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

"For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life." Do we really need a more powerful reminder of the im-



portance of Lent and Easter than that? That verse (from John 3:16) has become very popular in modern culture, to the point that we see it often at athletic events. When the University of Florida played for the national college football championship in 2009, quarterback Tim Tebow did not wear the regular eye black under his eyes. Under his right eye it said "John" and under his left eye it said "3:16." God sends us messages all the time, if we listen and are attentive. Tebow did not have a remarkable professional career, but he was the quarterback of the Denver Broncos against the Pittsburgh Steelers in the 2012 playoffs. The Broncos won, and in that game Tebow passed for 316 yards; his completed passes averaged 31.6 yards; perhaps the key play in the game came on third down and 16; the TV ratings for the game were 31.6%. That is not the important aspect, however. What is important is that the truth of that statement is so simple; nevertheless, it is difficult for us to completely grasp its significance. The truth is that God loves us, no matter what we are or what our attitude toward God is. The world that God gave His Son to save is our world. We are the children of God. REFLEXIÓN DE CORRESPONSABILIDAD



"Porque tanto amó Dios al mundo, que dio a su Hijo único, para que todo el que cree en él no perezca, sino que tenga vida eterna". ¿Realmente necesitamos un recordatorio más poderoso de la importancia de la Cuaresma y la Pascua que eso? Ese versículo (de Juan 3:16) se ha vuelto muy popular en la cultura moderna, hasta el punto de que lo vemos a menudo en eventos deportivos. Cuando la Universidad de Florida jugó para el campeonato nacional de fútbol universitario en 2009, el mariscal de campo Tim Tebow no usó el ojo normal negro bajo los ojos. Debajo de su ojo derecho decía "Juan" y debajo de su ojo izquierdo decía "3:16". Dios nos envía mensajes todo el tiempo, si escuchamos y estamos atentos. Tebow no tuvo una carrera profesional notable, pero fue el quarterback de los Denver Broncos contra los Pittsburgh Steelers en los playoffs de 2012. Los Broncos ganaron, y en ese juego Tebow pasó para 316 yardas; sus pases completos promediaron 31.6 yardas; quizás la jugada clave en el juego llegó en tercera oportunidad y 16; las clasificaciones de TV para el juego fueron 31.6%. Ese no es el aspecto importante, sin embargo. Lo importante es que la verdad de esa afirmación es tan simple; sin embargo, es difícil para nosotros captar por completo su significado. La verdad es que Dios nos ama, no importa lo que seamos o cuál sea nuestra actitud hacia Dios. El mundo que Dios le dio a Su Hijo para salvar es nuestro mundo. Somos los hijos de Dios. Esta temporada de Cuaresma es un tiempo para ver eso y aceptarlo como verdad.
