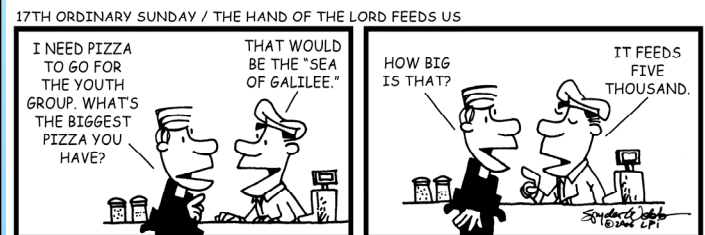

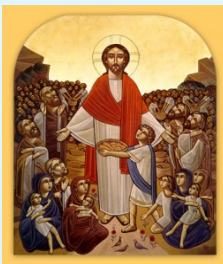

STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

Today’s Gospel reading recounts Jesus’ miracle of feeding the multitude. In a miracle that anticipated Jesus’ miracle of feeding the multitude, as reported in today’s Gospel, Elisha commanded that a small amount of bread be served to 100 men, and Jesus promised that all would indeed be fed. Elisha trusted that promise, acted upon it, and saw the promise miraculously fulfilled. We, like most people, tend to forget the miracles our Lord can work in everyday life. If we trust in God and live as good stewards, what we accomplish is, in its own way, a miracle. St. Paul beautifully sums up how our approach to living as Catholics and Christians should be. In today’s Second Reading from his letter to the Ephesians, Paul urges us to live “with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another through love, striving to preserve the unity of spirit through the bond of peace: one body and one Spirit.” Does that describe our parish community? This cannot happen unless we have the same kind of trust that Elisha had, and which St. Paul had, as well. Paul also says in today’s Second Reading, “I urge you to live in a manner worthy of the call you have received.” This is stewardship at its core. We should not give of our time, talent and treasure because we want to earn God’s love. He already loves us unconditionally. Jesus knew full well what miracle He was about to perform, but He also saw this as a chance to teach His Apostles, and also show us the way. Philip and the others had already seen Jesus perform many miracles, and there should have been no question in his mind about the divine resources Jesus had at His disposal. Yet Philip hesitated. It is human nature to be doubtful. Yet, as with Elisha, they all ate, and there was much left over. Through this miracle, Jesus is teaching us to trust Him and to do the same in our lives. And, by committing ourselves to a stewardship way of life, we can see our own gifts multiplied. And perhaps even perform our own modern-day miracles.

La lectura del Evangelio de hoy narra el milagro de Jesús de alimentar a la multitud. En un milagro que anticipó el milagro de Jesús de alimentar a la multitud, como se informa en el Evangelio de hoy, Eliseo ordenó que se sirviera una pequeña cantidad de pan a 100 hombres, y Jesús prometió que todos serían alimentados. Eliseo confiaba en esa promesa, actuó en consecuencia y vio la promesa cumplida milagrosamente. Nosotros, como la mayoría de las personas, solemos olvidar los milagros que nuestro Señor puede hacer en la vida cotidiana. Si confiamos en Dios y vivimos como buenos ma-

yordomos, lo que logramos es, a su manera, un milagro. San Pablo resume maravillosamente cómo debería ser nuestro enfoque de la vida como católicos y cristianos. En la segunda lectura de hoy, de su carta a los Efesios, Pablo nos urge a vivir "con toda humildad y dulzura, con paciencia, soportándonos unos a otros por amor, esforzándonos por preservar la unidad del espíritu a través del vínculo de paz: un cuerpo y uno Espíritu." "¿Eso describe nuestra comunidad parroquial? Esto no puede suceder a menos que tengamos el mismo tipo de confianza que tuvo Eliseo, y que también tuvo San Pablo. Paul también dice en la Segunda Lectura de hoy: "Le insto a vivir de una manera digna de la llamada que ha recibido". Esta es la corresponsabilidad en su núcleo. No debemos dar nuestro tiempo, talento y tesoro porque queremos ganar el amor de Dios. El ya nos ama incondicionalmente. Jesús sabía muy bien qué milagro estaba a punto de realizar, pero también vio esto como una oportunidad para enseñar a Sus Apóstoles, y también nos mostró el camino. Felipe y los demás ya habían visto a Jesús realizar muchos milagros, y no debería haber ninguna duda en su mente acerca de los recursos divinos que Jesús tenía a su disposición. Sin embargo, Felipe dudó. Es la naturaleza humana ser dudoso. Sin embargo, como con Eliseo, todos comieron, y quedaba mucho. A través de este milagro, Jesús nos está enseñando a confiar en Él y a hacer lo mismo en nuestras vidas. Y, al comprometernos con una forma de vida de corresponsabilidad, podemos ver multiplicados nuestros propios dones. Y tal vez incluso realizar nuestros propios milagros modernos.
